## **Orange County Flooding Impacting Travel** *32 Roads, 1 Bridge Closed*

**(Goshen, N.Y.)** – Orange County Executive Edward A. Diana advises residents that recent rainfall coupled with melting snow has resulted in severe flooding today across Orange County that is impacting travel. The County is under a Flood warning, with the Wallkill River and Ramapo River experiencing high water levels. There are thirty-two road closures and one bridge closed due to the flooding.

“Our Emergency Operations Center is open and staffed, closely monitoring the situation and working with local governments,” said County Executive Diana. “I urge residents to take caution in the affected areas.”

As of 12:00 p.m. the following roads and bridge **are closed**:

- Blooming Grove: Barnes Road and Tuthill Road
- Cornwall: Taylor Road
- Deerpark: Big Pond Road and Academy Avenue
- Greenville: Minisink Turnpike, Rackett Road and Toad Pasture
- Hamptonburgh: Twin Branch Road, McBride Lane, and County Route 4
- Montgomery: Chandler Road and Canning Road
- Town of Newburgh: Mount Airy Road, Beattie Road, and Gardnertown Road
- Wallkill: Midway Park Road
- Warwick: State School Road and Pennula Road
- Wawayanda: Echo Lake Road and McVeigh Road
- Woodbury: Hunter Street
- Cornwall-on-Hudson: Shore Road
- Harriman: North Main Street
- Village of Monroe: Rye Hill Road
- Walden: Wooster Grove Park
- Washingtonville: Route 94, Cardinal Drive and Patricia Lane
- Palisades Parkway: Exit 15 North, and Exit 19 North
- Tuxedo: County Route 106
- Tuxedo: East Main Street Bridge
