Orange County Storm Report, 3/10/11 at 4:30 pm

Goshen, N.Y. – With heavy rain expected for our area later this evening and throughout the over night hours, Orange County Executive Edward A. Diana urges residents in flood prone areas of the County to closely monitor water levels and weather reports, and visit the County's website at www.orangecountygov.com for flood preparedness information, updated storm information, including road closures.

"I ask that residents be cautious in maintaining their safety during this storm, especially when driving," said County Executive Diana. "Please do not drive through flooded roads."

Currently, Orange County is still in a **flood watch**. However, the area along the Wallkill River is under a **flood warning**.

Based on the latest information, as of 4:30 pm today, the following roads are closed:

- Canning Road in Montgomery
- County Route 106 in Tuxedo
- Route 211 in Mount Hope
- Miller Road in Wallkill
- Big Pond Road in Deerpark
- Gardinertown Road in Town of Newburgh
