Orange County Storm Report, 3/11/11 at 6:00 am

Goshen, N.Y. – Orange County has experienced significant flooding in many portions of the County due to the heavy rain that took place in the overnight hours, with the ground is saturated and many rivers, creeks and streams are already at high levels.

Currently, Orange County is still in a **flood watch**. However, the area along the Wallkill River is under a **flood warning**.

In the Town of Tuxedo, the following roads are closed:

- Route 17A East and West
- Route 17 North and South
- Benjamin Meadow Road

There is no access to the New York State Thruway in the Town of Tuxedo.

As of 6:00 a.m., the following roads and bridges **are closed**:

- Canning Road in Montgomery
- County Route 106 in Tuxedo
- Route 211 in Mount Hope
- Miller Road in Wallkill
- Big Pond Road in Deerpark
- Gardinertown Road in Town of Newburgh
- Route 17 in Tuxedo in Deerpark (near Sullivan County)
- Pine Hill Rd in Chester
- Howelles Turnpike in Wallkill
- County Route 61 in Deerpark
- Forster Ave in Warwick
- Ulsterville Rd in Crawford
- Route 17 A in Tuxedo
- Route 209 at Route 211 in Deerpark

Residents are reminded that it is against the law to drive around road barriers.
