**GOSHEN** – Orange County Executive Edward A. Diana and Deputy Commissioner of Emergency Management Seamus K. Leary confirm the following municipality specific cooling center information for residents as a respite from the high heat and humidity our area is currently experiencing:

### **City of Newburgh**

The City of Newburgh has designated the Activity Center at 401 Washington Street as a temporary cooling center for area residents. The center will be open from 11 a.m. to 7:30 p.m. through Saturday, July 23. For additional information please call (845) 565-3230.

The City of Newburgh will also be extending the operating hours of the Delano Hitch Recreation Park (DHRP) pool through Saturday, July 23. Extended hours will be from 12:30 p.m. to 7:30 p.m. The DHRP pool is co-located with the Activity Center at 401 Washington Street in Newburgh.
