Orange County Government Center Closed Wednesday, August 31 *Excessive rain from hurricane the cause*

(Goshen, NY) – Deputy County Executive of Orange County James D. O'Donnell, in consultation with County Executive Edward A. Diana, will close the Orange County Government Center at 255 Main Street in Goshen tomorrow, Wednesday, August 31 for a third day due to damage the building sustained as a result of excessive rain during Hurricane Irene.

Those constituents in need of DMV services may visit the County's satellite DMV offices in the cities of Middletown at 14 King Street; Newburgh at 128 Broadway; and, Port Jervis at 20 Hammond Street. Residents may take advantage of extended hours at the Newburgh DMV office on Thursday until 7:30 for DMV and passport services.

Those individuals who have reporting requirements with Orange County's Department of Probation, located at the Orange County Government Center in Goshen, will be contacted by their probation officers.

Orange County Government Center employees should report tomorrow to the location they were assigned by their department head and/or supervisor, at their normal reporting time.
