Orange County Announces Relocation of County Clerk Services *Title Search Records to be Available at Valley View's Parry Building*

Goshen – Following the move of nearly 8,000 sq. ft. of documents from the County Clerk's offices in the closed Orange County Government Center, real estate title searchers and others will be able to access records at the Parry Building on the Valley View campus beginning Monday, September 19, from 9 am to 5 pm (Monday through Friday).

"The County Clerk's staff, DPW workers, and movers did a Herculean job of moving many decades' worth of records from the Government Center in just a few days," said County Executive Diana. "We were extremely fortunate that the majority of the documentation needed was available at the Real Property office in Goshen so that the County's real estate business could continue with very little loss of time. I appreciate the flexibility and patience everyone exhibited as we made the transition from the Government Center to the Parry Building," continued Mr. Diana.

Additional relocation of County Clerk services are as follows:

- Department of Motor Vehicles continues to offer services out of the Middletown, Newburgh, and Port Jervis offices. There are no DMV services available in Goshen at this time.
- Passport applications and processing – 11 Quarry Road, Goshen
- Pistol Permits and Veterans Discount Cards – 110 Wells Farm Road, Goshen
