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Orange County Announces New Senior Dining Site *Montgomery Senior Center to provide lunches Monday through Friday*

GOSHEN – Orange County Executive Edward A. Diana and Ann Marie Maglione, Director, Office for the Aging, are pleased to announce the opening of a new senior dining site at the Montgomery Senior Center at 31 Bridge Street in the Village of Montgomery. The new facility will begin serving lunch to seniors on Wednesday, September 21. Lunch will be served Monday through Friday at 11:30 a.m.

“Many of our County’s seniors are in need of hot, nutritious meals in order to maintain their health and well-being,” said County Executive Diana. “By participating in the Senior Dining Program they are ensured of having a meal that is planned by a dietician to provide one-third of their daily nutritional requirements. Equally important, seniors who participate in the dining program enjoy time out of the house to socialize and visit with friends,” continued Mr. Diana.

Lunch reservations must be made 24 hours in advance by calling 492-1245. There is no charge for the meal, but a \$3 donation is suggested. All funds are used to sustain and expand the Senior Dining Program. Orange County senior dining sites are open to any resident over the age of 60.

The Senior Dining Program was instituted in response to the Older Americans Act to ensure nutritional security and socialization for senior citizens.
