STATEMENT BY COUNTY EXECUTIVE DIANA REGARDING FEMA PUBLIC ASSISTANCE FOR ORANGE COUNTY FROM LEE

(Goshen, NY) – Orange County Executive Edward A. Diana today issued the following statement:

Late yesterday, FEMA announced that Orange County would now be eligible for disaster assistance to help pay for emergency response costs and repairs to damaged facilities as a result of Tropical Storm Lee.

I am very pleased with this designation because it will now give us access to federal funds that are critical as we proceed to restore Orange County's infrastructure, which was badly damaged during the storm.
